SMITH COVE PARK DEVELOPMENT

Seattle Parks and Recreation invites the community to participate in the design of Smith Cove Park. Join Seattle Parks and Recreation staff and Gustafson Guthrie Nichol (GGN) to review and provide input on the schematic design for your new waterfront park. Thank you to everyone who participated in the first meeting. We encourage you to attend and see how your input has helped shape the design.

Smith Cove Park is located just west of Pier 91 at the foot of Magnolia Hill on Elliott Bay. This project will develop the 4.9 acre easterly waterfront portion of Smith Cove Park and make improvements to the playfield half of Smith Cove Park (west of 23rd Ave. W). The improved park will provide opportunities for active and passive recreation for all ages and abilities, increase environmental-sensitivity, and make the park inviting and usable for more people.

In 2015, the Friends of Smith Cove Park (FoSCP) received a grant from the City of Seattle Department of Neighborhoods to undertake the initial public outreach and conceptual design for the expansion of Smith Cove Park. In early 2016 Seattle Parks and Recreation hired GGN as the design consultant. They used the outreach and concept completed by the FoSCP as the starting point for the design of the park. Amenities may include pathways, landscaping, waterfront access, a play area, and related improvements. Improvements will also be made to the existing part of Smith Cove Park used for youth sports to enhance the playability.
